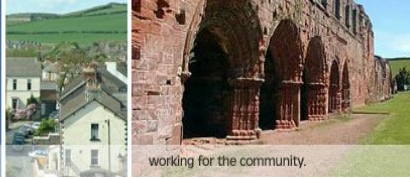

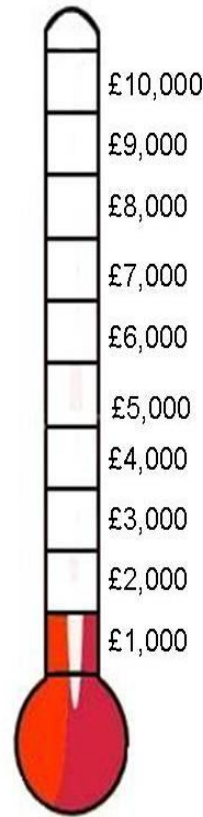

Current Team Status

We are please to announce that the Dalton Team is growing from Strength to strength with 13 members now fully associated to the Dalton Community Response. The group has been meeting now for many weeks and continue to grow as a team through team building exercises and training in a numerous amount of area, all of which will give them further knowledge when they become fully operational. To that end there 10 weeks of Training with the Northwest Ambulance Service has started at Dowdales School in Dalton who have been fantastic in allowing space to complete the training , for which we are completely in there debt.

The Swift Water /White water rescue is also growing with team members coming from Barrow, Dalton and Ulverston , from many different occupations , but all with the same goal , to safe lives and to provide a valuable service to the local community.

The team relies on donations and sponsorship to be able to offer a dedicated and professional Search and Rescue service, 365 days a year in all weathers.
